Record of Decision for the Wilton Rancheria Fee-to-Trust and Casino Project, Sacramento County, California

AGENCY: Bureau of Indian Affairs, Interior

ACTION: Notice of Availability

SUMMARY: The Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary – Indian Affairs made a final agency determination to acquire 35.92 acres, more or less, in the City of Elk Grove, Sacramento County, California (Site) in trust for the Wilton Rancheria for gaming and other purposes on January 19, 2017.

This notice advises the public that the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) as lead agency has filed a Record of Decision (ROD) for the Wilton Rancheria's (Tribe) proposed 35.92-acre fee-to-trust acquisition and casino project. This notice also announces that the ROD has been made available to the public. The 35.92-acre project site is located immediately west of Highway 99, north of Kammerer Road, and east of Promenade Parkway.
